A legendary challenge in the words of Museo Alfa Romeo and Mauto

Mille Miglia 1947. In this first edition after the Second World War, two cars representing two different eras challenged each other: the **Alfa Romeo 8C 2900 B Lungo** incarnated the highest expression of the pre-war Sports vehicle, in the races as well as in the concours d'élégance, while the **Cisitalia 202** was essential, modern, and clearly projected towards the future. David versus Goliath: the challenge until the last metre between a majestic granturismo and a slim and swift spider, driven by a bedevilled Tazio Nuvolari in one of his last, great endeavours.
